SRHD's Treatment Services division houses the Opioid Treatment Program, which provides medications for opioid use disorder (MOUD) for individuals seeking recovery from opioids. The program is state and federally accredited to provide outpatient treatment, counseling and referral services for individuals with opioid use disorder.

SRHD began providing opioid treatment services to the Spokane community in 1990 to address an increase in heroin use. Today, Treatment Services is the singular largest opioid treatment provider in Washington state.

Services

Clients receive personalized treatment with a combination of medication and therapy-based services that promotes harm reduction and supports the individual in the process of their recovery journey from opioids while supporting the individual's mental and physical well-being with the ultimate goal of providing each individual with whole person care.

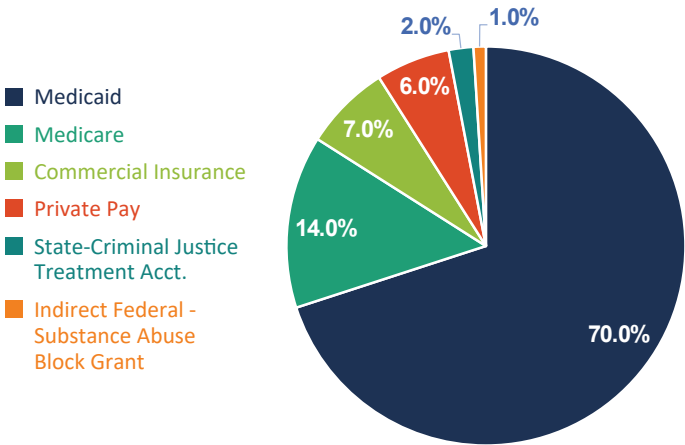
Medication-assisted treatment at Treatment Services helps patients manage withdrawal symptoms with methadone or buprenorphine. Clients also receive one-on-one and group counseling, health physicals, mental health counseling, and referrals to outside community partners as needed.

Enrollment

Clients must participate in a medical intake and biopsychosocial assessment and urine drug screen to enroll in the program. Once enrolled, clients work with program staff to understand their outcomes and together, develop goals and customized individual service plans (ISP) that include medication management therapy, counseling, and health and physical monitoring.
