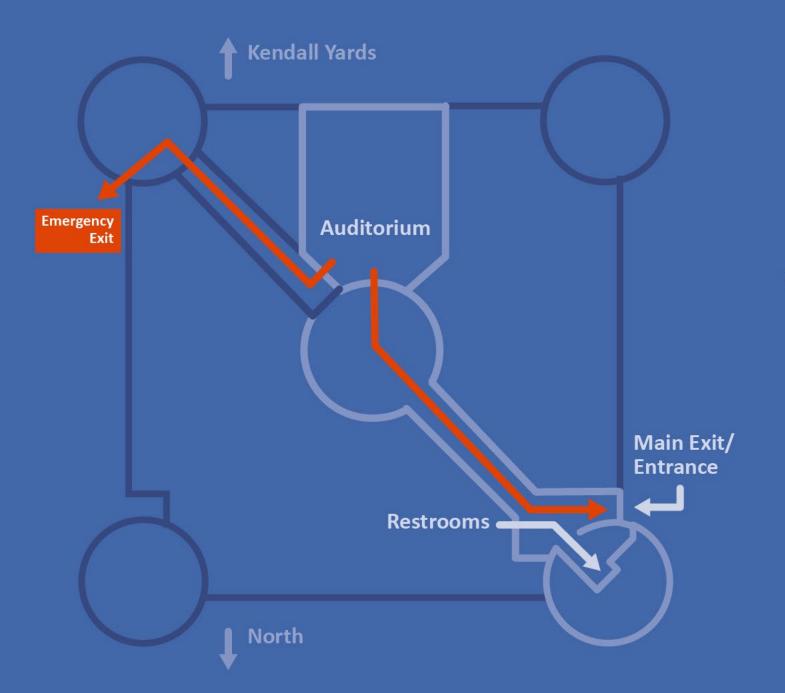

Tribal Board of Health Member Process



Who is eligible?

- WHEREAS, the 2025 Washington State Legislature under ESHB1946 ("Act") passed legislation addressing the compositions and appointments to local boards of health which requires local Boards of Health to include:
- One (1) representative for each federally recognized Indian tribe that holds reservation or trust land within a county ("Tribe") selected by the Tribe which notifies the American Indian health commission, and
- One (1) representative for each urban Indian organization recognized by the Indian Health services and registered as a 501 (c)(3) organization in Washington that services American Indian and Alaska Native People providing services within a county ("Organization") selected by the Organization which notifies the American Indian health commission.



How to submit your selection for the BOH


State & Federal Updates as of 6.23.2025

Foundational Public Health Services reduced funding to SRHD by \$150,000


- One program that had not yet started = \$100,000

Treatment Services Monthly Numbers

Intakes

The number of days between referral status and admitted status. Patients who are seen on the same day will Days from Referral to Admit have zero days. This number is an average of all the patients each month.

When a patient is turned away for services, they are assigned a medical record number (MRN). That number allows Treatment Intakes turned away Services (TS) to track how many patients were turned away and have returned to sign up for services again.

Intakes returned/admitted When a patient is turned away for services and returns on a different day and is able to be admitted into the program.

Transfers/Discharges Patients that transferred to another facility or discontinued services with TS for a variety of reasons.

Dispensing

Unique OTP patients served Specific unduplicated patients who are provided care within TS.

Unique Courtesy Dosing Unduplicated patients who are receiving services through TS whose primary clinic is not SRHD. Patients Served

Methadone Doses Dispensed Total number of methadone doses dispensed to all individuals in that timeframe.
