

FOUR STEPS TO GETTING YOUR FOOD WORKER CARD

All food workers that handle unwrapped foods or beverages in Spokane County are required to have a valid Washington State Food Worker card from a local health jurisdiction in Washington.

Step 1. Take the Approved Course

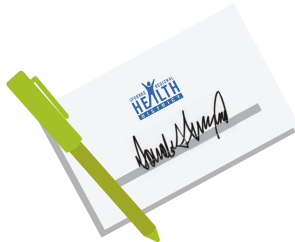

New cards are good for two years. If renewed 60 days or less before the card expires, the new card will be good for three years.
