FINANCIAL REPORT – Kim Kramarz, Controller

- Agency expenses are at 79.8% and revenue is at 83.8% The agency has received all of Spokane County's contribution for the year. Reserves are at 28%.
- The COVID-19 budget has \$100,000 remaining of the DOH ELC19 funding and \$232,000 in Spokane County CARES funding that is expected to be exhausted by November expenses. The ELC20 funding of \$5.2 million and DOH Vaccine Services funds of \$1.6 million will move forward into 2022.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER'S REPORT – Amelia Clark, Administrative Officer

- The new Facilities manager will begin December 16.
- The Human Resources manager interviews will be held next week.
- Budget implementation will begin this afternoon with a communication to staff.
- The Administrative Officer and Health Officer have met with community agencies on the possession of controlled substances and information from the meetings will be shared with the Spokane Health Advisory Council.

HEALTH OFFICER REPORT – Francisco Velázquez, MD, SM, FCAP, Health Officer

- There are currently two cases of Omicron in the United States. The Delta virus is trending down in the United States.
- There are 218 COVID-19 cases reported in Spokane County today. In Spokane County, 61.1% of the population has been fully vaccinated.
- The Health District has distributed 146,524 tests to the community.
- The Test to Stay program used by the State of Washington was developed in Spokane.

BOARD MEMBER CHECK IN

• Board member Frostad thanked staff for their work and vouched for the Administrative Officer and Health Officer's integrity, character, and their efforts to make the right decisions for the agency and community.
