## **ACTION ITEMS**

### **FINANCIAL REPORT** – *Kim Kramarz, Controller*

- Expenses are at 30%. Funding and revenues are at 26.5% due to the delay in receiving grant billed funds. Unassigned reserves are at 20%. Committed reserve funds are at \$1.5 million. Assigned reserves are at \$1.8 million.
- The annual report is due May 30, 2022. The audit will be scheduled soon.

# ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER'S REPORT – Amelia Clark, Administrative Officer

- Contracts for construction on the leased Treatment Services building will be brought to the Board for consideration in June and July.
- The June BOH meeting will be held in person.
- The Washington State Board of Health has released rule making documents for boards of health structure. Documents have been shared with general counsel for a SRHD BOH bylaws update.

# HEALTH OFFICER REPORT – Francisco Velázquez, MD, SM, FCAP, Health Officer

- BA2 and BA2.12.1 are responsible for most of the increases in COVID-19 within the country. BA2 is the most prominent within region 10.
- Spokane County had a 15% increase in COVID-19 cases within the last week. There are currently 36 patients in the hospital to include one in ICU and one in the pediatric ICU.
- There are currently 58 hospitalizations for influenza including several pediatric cases.
- There are 429 cases of pediatric hepatitis in the country. Over 90% of cases have required hospitalization. Five deaths have been reported.
- There were 75 cases of Avian Influenza in animals on one, non-commercial farm within Spokane County
- The SRHD Disease Prevention & Response division has been providing Narcan distribution and testing and vaccination clinics at Camp Hope for hepatitis C, syphilis, and HIV. There are 350+ individuals within the camp. The division convened a meeting with City of Spokane officials to bring awareness of SRHD's presence in the camp and to share Department of Health's recommendations for containment of disease which resulted in 16 portable bathrooms placed within the camp by a grant from Better Health Together.

#### **AGENCY REPORTS**

 Michelle Fossum, SRHD Legal Counsel, provided a presentation on the updated Open Public Meetings Act (OPMA). Recommendations by the attorney include language within the bylaws about emergency meetings, language to address public comment, board member telephonic participation, and language about voting on permits and fees by BOH members. Public comment for the June Board meeting will be due in writing by June 29 at 12:00 p.m.
