FINANCIAL REPORT – Kim Kramarz, Controller

- The year-end books were closed May 30 and the 2021 audit began June 1.
- The indirect, division, and program 2023 budget development will begin in July.
- The agency is at 37% of its budget and at 34% of its revenue. Fifty percent of Foundational Public Health Services and two installments of Spokane County funding have been received.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER'S REPORT - Amelia Clark, Administrative Officer

- The SRHD Administrative Officer has completed 2019 assignments from the BOH Transition Committee to include agency finance, organizational structure, and local focus.
- The Deputy Administrative Officer, Lola Phillips, will be introduced at the July 28 meeting. A staff communication regarding the ad-hoc transition and search committee will be sent to staff today.

HEALTH OFFICER REPORT – Francisco Velázquez, MD, SM, FCAP, Health Officer

- Currently, no COVID BA4 or BA5 variants have been detected in Spokane County. Vaccine providers are beginning to work on a new vaccine to cover COVID BA4 and BA5 strains which is expected to be available this fall.
- The 7-day rate of COVID infections in Spokane is currently 220.4 cases per 100,000. Daily hospital admissions are 4.1 which is a decrease from last month.
- There are 306 monkey pox cases in the nation with six in Seattle-King County area and none reported in Spokane County.
