

No Smoking or Vaping in Public Places

A Guide for Spokane County Businesses and Their Employees

• REQUIRED •

Businesses are required to post "No Smoking. No Vaping." signs at all entrances. Retail establishments must also post signage in prominent areas throughout the workplace.

• REQUIRED •

Prohibit smoking and vaping within 25 feet of entrances, exits, windows that open, and ventilation intakes that serve the enclosed area where smoking is prohibited.

• REQUIRED •

Prohibit smoking and vaping indoors.

• REQUIRED •

Prohibit smoking and vaping in places of employment. This includes patios and other outdoor seating and dining areas that employees are required to serve or clean.

SMOKING & VAPING AREA

The law applies to all forms of lighted smoking products including tobacco, cigar, hookah, marijuana and vaping products.

RCW 70.160 and SRHD Resolution #16-01 protects people from secondhand smoke and vapor by prohibiting smoking and vaping in public places and places of employment.
