Begin Medication

Begin medication at home. Follow provider's instructions for taking with/ without food and for missed or late doses.

Mid-Treatment Labs

Provider type: phlebotomist

Location: clinic

Test type: blood draw

Complete Medication

Complete prescribed course of treatment (typically 8-12 weeks).

Step

SVR12 Labs

Provider type: phlebotomist

Location: clinic

SVR12 labs assess your sustained virologic response 12 weeks after you complete treatment. If this test is negative, you are considered to be cured—HCV free!
