

Spokane Regional Health District (SRHD) is accepting applications for a vacancy on its School Advisory Committee. The purpose of this committee is to advise SRHD's School Health & Safety program on issues affecting Spokane County's K-12 school-related community. Committee members act as liaisons between this community and SRHD.

The committee is comprised of ten members; one school district superintendent, one school district risk manager/safety officer (who is directly related to and responsible for student safety), one school district maintenance director/supervisor, one private/parochial school administrator, one private/parochial school safety representative (who is directly related to and responsible for student safety), one public school principal, one school nurse, one architect/engineer (with experience in K-12 school construction projects) and two SRHD representatives. Committee members must be willing to serve a two-year term and must be able to attend four annual meetings, held the second Thursday of January, March, May, and October, from 1:00 – 2:30 p.m. Most, if not all, of the meetings are held virtually via Microsoft Teams. The current vacant positions are public district maintenance director/supervisor, private/parochial school administrator, and architect/engineer. The first term for this position runs from October 2024 through October 2026.
